The SAM is an educational tool that contains installation best practices for all individual CertainTeed residential roofing products, the Integrity Roof System, Flintlastic SA modified-bitumen rolled roofing as well as other topics important to the success of roofing contractors.
- Two or more company employees have earned the Master Craftsman® Shingle Quality Specialist™ designation after passing a test on the CertainTeed Shingle Technology Manual, which strengthens their knowledge of shingle products, quality standards and satisfying customer objectives.

Shingles are just the beginning - to keep your new roof performing and looking great for years to come it takes a complete CertainTeed Integrity Roof System approach.

1. Waterproofing Underlayment

The first step in your defense against the elements. Self-adhering underlayment is installed at vulnerable areas of your roof to help prevent leaks from wind-driven rain and ice dams.

2. Water-Resistant Underlayment

Provides a protective layer over the roof deck and acts as a secondary barrier against leaks.

3. Shingle Starter

Designed to work in tandem with the roof shingles above for optimal shingle sealing and performance.

4. Shingles

Choose from a variety of Good-Better-Best styles to complement any roof design and fit your budget.

5. Ventilation

A roof that breathes is shown to perform better and last longer. Ridge Vents, in combination with Intake Vents, allow air to flow on the underside of your roof deck, keeping the attic cooler in the summer and drier in the winter.

6. Hip & Ridge


Available in numerous profiles, these accessories are used on the roof's hip and ridge lines for a distinctive finishing touch to your new roof.

Metal Flashings

In order to qualify for the SureStart PLUS 5-STAR Warranty, all metal flashings on the roof must be replaced, including step, sidewall, chimney, drip edge, skylight flashing, etc.

For Patriot® and Patriot® XL shingles the manufacturing defect must cause leaks.

Fully transferable from the original property owner/consumer to the first subsequent owner for 20 years from the date of installation—five years longer than the typical warranty.

*Applies to single-family detached houses. Duration for all other types of structures is limited to 30 years.

Low-Slope Roof Sections: If a project being roofed with CertainTeed shingles has a low-slope section that will be roofed with our Flintlastic® SA, or our SMARTCOAT™ systems, SureStart PLUS extends FULL coverage for the duration of the low-slope warranted period, depending on the level of protection you choose. Residential shingles must be a minimum of one and a half times (1.5X) the amount of flat roof submitted (low-slope square maximum may apply). See Low-Slope Residential Limited Warranty for system requirements and warranty durations.


